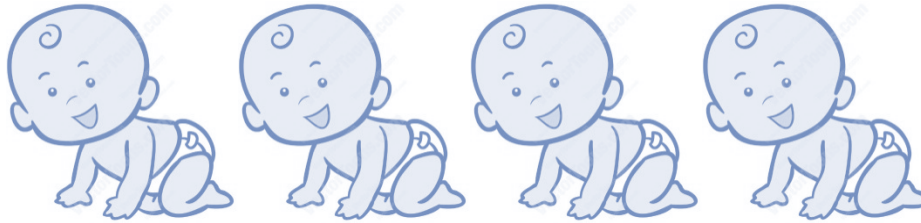


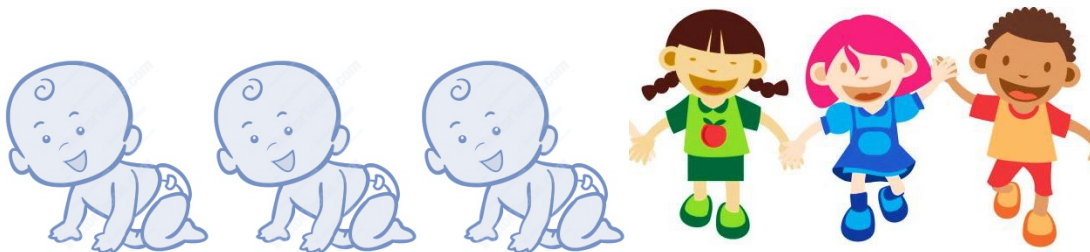
With a license for a **SMALL** Family Child Care home, you can provide care for the following **ONLY**:

4 infants ONLY



OR-----

6 children → no more than 3 infants



OR-----

8 children → no more than 2 infants, one child enrolled in kindergarten, and one child at least 6 years of age.



Reminders:

- *An infant is a child under the age of 2 (24 months)*
- You must notify the parents of the children in care when caring for more than 6 children. (Form LIC 9150)
- If you rent or lease your home, you must have permission from your landlord to care for more than 6 children. (Form LIC 9149)
- One of the two school age children needs to be 6 years old or older, and one needs to be enrolled in and currently attending kindergarten

With a license for a **LARGE** Family Child Care Home, you can provide care for the following **ONLY**, with a qualified assistant:

12 Children- no more than 4 infants



14 Children- no more than 3 infants and one child enrolled in kindergarten, and one child at least 6 years old



- When there is no Qualified Assistant, 14 years of age or older present, the capacity reverts back to the requirements for a Small Family Child Care.
- You must notify the parents of the children in care when caring for more than 12 children.(LIC 9150) If you rent or lease your home, you must have permission from your landlord to care for more than 12 children.(LIC 9149)
