
With a license for a **SMALL** Family Child Care home, you can provide care for the following **ONLY**:

4 infants ONLY



6 children → no more than 3 infants



8 children > no more than 2 infants, one child enrolled in kindergarten,



and one child at least 6 years of age.

Reminders:

- An infant is a child under the age of 2 (24 months)
- You <u>must</u> notify the parents of the children in care when caring for more than 6 children. (Form LIC 9150)
- If you rent or lease your home, you must have permission from your landlord to care for more than 6 children. (Form LIC 9149)
- One of the two school age children needs to be 6 years old or older, and one needs to be enrolled in and currently attending kindergarten

OR -

With a license for a **LARGE** Family Child Care Home, you can provide care for the following **ONLY**, with a qualified assistant:

12 Children- no more than 4 infants



14 Children- no more than 3 infants and one child enrolled in kindergarten, and one child at least 6 years old



- When there is no Qualified Assistant, 14 years of age or older present, the capacity reverts back to the requirements for a Small Family Child Care.
- You <u>must</u> notify the parents of the children in care when caring for more than 12 children.(LIC 9150) If you rent or lease your home, you <u>must</u> have permission from your landlord to care for more than 12 children.(LIC 9149)
