NEW APPLICANTS

Income is projected for the **next 12 months** for new applicants.

| Number in Household | 200% of Federal Poverty Level | Up to 50% Medical | Limit |
|----------------------------|--------------------------------------|--------------------------|--------------|
| 1 | \$27,180 | \$13,590 | \$40,770 |
| 2 | \$36,620 | \$18,310 | \$54,930 |
| 3 | \$46,060 | \$23,030 | \$69,090 |
| 4 | \$55,500 | \$27,750 | \$83,250 |

Add \$9,440 for each additional family member over four.

ENROLLED GRANDPARENTS

Income is counted for the **past 12 months** for enrolled volunteers.

| Number in Household | Plus 20% | Up to 50% Medical | Limit |
|----------------------------|-----------------|--------------------------|--------------|
| 1 | \$32,616 | \$16,308 | \$48,924 |
| 2 | \$43,944 | \$21,972 | \$65,916 |
| 3 | \$55,272 | \$27,636 | \$82,908 |
| 4 | \$66,600 | \$33,300 | \$99,900 |

Adjust accordingly for families with five or more members.
